## Saints of the Week

### JANUARY 13<sup>th</sup>

St. Hilary, a bishop from Poitiers; married and convert from paganism; a leading opponent of Arianism (doctrine denying that Jesus was of the same substance as God, but only of the highest of created beings) in the West; his most noted work was "De Trinitate." He died in 367.

### JANUARY 17<sup>th</sup>

St. Anthony, an Abbot; he was born in upper Egypt; a hermit and early founder of religious life; he was called the "Patriarch of Monks;" he aided St. Athanasius of Alexandria (May 2<sup>nd</sup>) in combating Arianism (see under St. Hilary); he died in 356 at age 105.
