From the Pastor's Desk

Under Mosaic Law, the wife, if she loses her husband, is never finished if he has a lineup of brothers ready to take his place. This may provide insight as we join Jesus in answering the Sadducee's questions about marriage on earth and marriage in heaven. Their "what if" proposition about a succession of brothers doing their duty and marrying her poses the question: "Whose wife will she be in heaven?"

Jesus' words in the Gospel this weekend indicate that when God has a relationship with someone, nothing, not even death, can destroy that relationship. In his struggle to explain the mystery of resurrected life, Paul expressed a similar idea to the churches in Rome: "I am certain that neither death nor life...not any other creature will be able to separate us from the love of God that comes to us in Christ Jesus" (Rom 8:38-39). Just as Paul was certain about this continuing relationship with God and with Jesus, so may every believer be sure that death is not the end; it is merely a passage to a fuller and forever relationship with the God who loves us.

The month of November begins the holiday season; as such please put our annual Thanksgiving Mass on November 28th your calendar. The liturgy is at 9:30 a.m., early enough for you to come and worship with our school children and parish community and then go home to feast with family and friends.

These next few weeks, our children will work diligently, learning about Thanksgiving and each class will focus on something that they are truly thankful for.

As always on this day, students from Transfiguration School will do the readings and fully participate in the liturgy through song and dance. Our school drum line and praise dancers will also repeat the performance they did at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels in October. Please plan on attending this very special liturgy. Sunday, November 10, 2013 - 4:00 PM

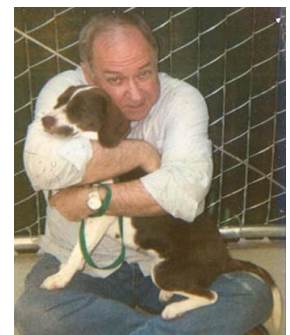
