## Black History Notes......Black Women Religious

This week I want to spotlight Black Women Religious both past and contemporary. Surely these women have contributed greatly to Catholic Church and African American Catholics with their zeal to bring the gospel of the Lord to our society. First, there is **Mother Mary Lang, OSP** (Oblate Sisters of Providence) founder. This is the oldest religious order in the United States of America. The Oblates made it their mission to educate Blacks and Indians in the United States. They started this before the Civil War and continued after reconstruction and into the present. **Mother Henriette Delille,** is the founder of the Sisters of the Holy Family in New Orleans, an order composed of free women of color. The order provided nursing care and a home for orphans, later establishing schools as well. **Sr. Thea Bowman, F.S.P.A, Ph.D.** (1937-1990), is the first African-American woman to receive a Doctorate in Theology from Boston College. A Franciscan Sister of Perpetual Adoration; she was a charismatic evangelist calling black Catholics to their rightful place and to the expression of their culture within the Church, advocate and consultant for intercultural awareness for the Diocese of Jackson; scholar of English Language and literature expert in the Renaissance and the works of William Faulkner.

In the present we have two that must be mentioned. **Sr. Eva Marie Lumas**, **SSS, DMin**, is a Sister of Social Service of Los Angeles. She has a Doctorate of Ministry degree from Howard University in Washington, D.C. She is the Cultural Competency Trainer at. St. Mary's Center in Oakland, CA and served as both Assistant professor of Faith and Culture and Director of Field Education at the Franciscan School of Theology in Berkeley, CA. She is also an Adjunct Professor of catechesis and Pastoral Studies at the Institute for Black Catholic Studies at Xavier University of Louisiana. **Sr./Dr. Oralisa Martin** received her Doctorate of Ministry from Howard University. She is the founder of the African American Catholic Catechetical Conference in Los Angeles. She travels extensively giving revivals, retreats, and keynote addresses. In addition, she provides in-service training for Catholic School teachers teaching Black learners.
